

Pocket Pilot 3.0 Onboarding

X10 (EB/SB/INTB/NAB)

Requirements for using JURA Pocket Pilot 3.0:

- JURA Business Connect
- Compatible automatic coffee machine
- PC or notebook with an internet connection
- Smartphone (with the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app installed)
- JURA Pocket Pilot account (instructions below)

Check versions:

- Is the latest version of the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app installed?
- Android version 8.0 (or higher)
- iOS version 16.0 (or higher)
- Bluetooth version 4.0 (or higher)

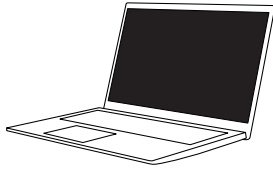
Check permissions:

- Are Location Services for the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app turned on?
- Have all permissions been given to the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app?
- Is Bluetooth on your smartphone turned on?

Check Wi-Fi settings:

- Router frequency set to 2.4 GHz (not 5 GHz)
- Make sure your Wi-Fi uses WPA2-Personal (not WPA2-Enterprise)
- Channels 1 to 11 (not higher)
- Disable 20/40 MHz Coexistence
- The Wi-Fi password must be known

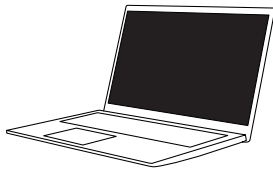
Registration via pocketpilot.jura.com



- ▶ Click on “Login with your JURA account”
- ▶ Click on “Register now”
- ▶ Check your email inbox and confirm your email address

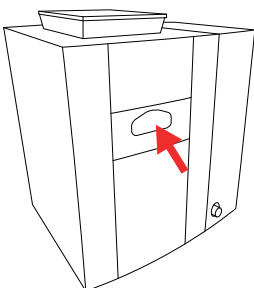

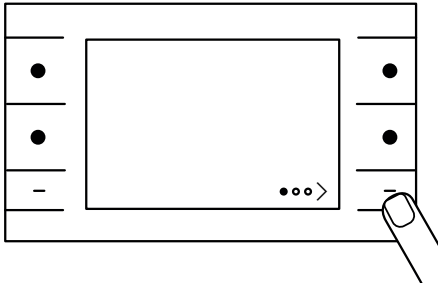
- ▶ Add a name, a location, the currency and the region for your company.
- ▶ Click on “Save”

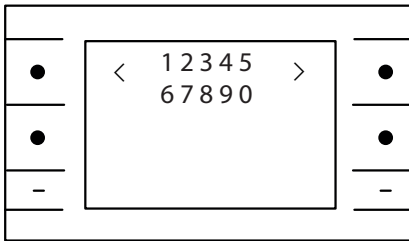
- ▶ Download the **JURA Pocket Pilot Management app** (App Store or Google Play)
- ▶ Connect your smartphone to the Wi-Fi and switch on Bluetooth.
- ▶ Open the location settings.
- ▶ Always allow location access for the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app.



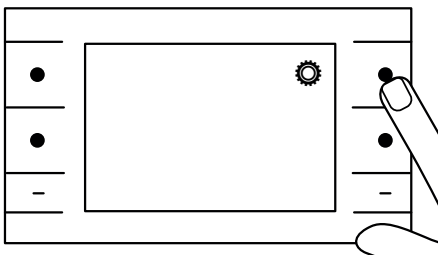
- ▶ Turn off the coffee machine.
- ▶ Remove the cover with the JURA logo on the back of the coffee machine by sliding it downwards.
- ▶ Plug the Business Connect into the coffee machine’s service socket. (Some models already have it plugged in.)
- ▶ Switch on the coffee machine.



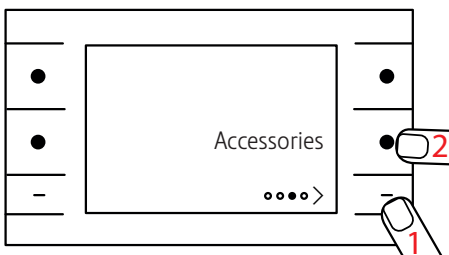
- ▶ Press the > button for **approx. 2 seconds** to enter the JURA Cockpit.



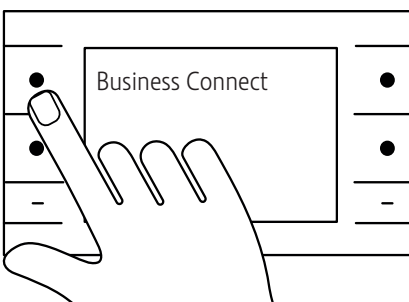
- ▶ Enter the default PIN **“000000”** to access the Cockpit.



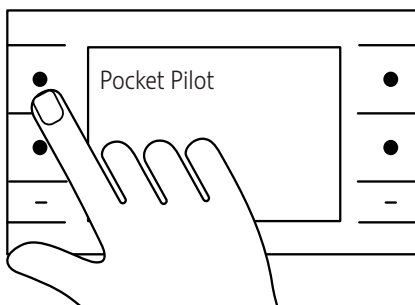
- ▶ Press the ⚙ button.



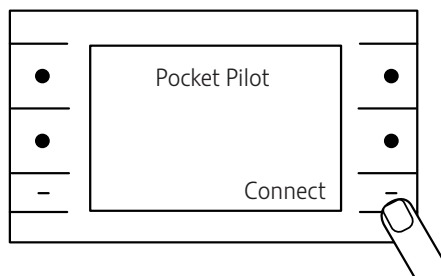
- ▶ Press the > button several times until page ○○●○ is displayed. Press the 'Accessories' button.



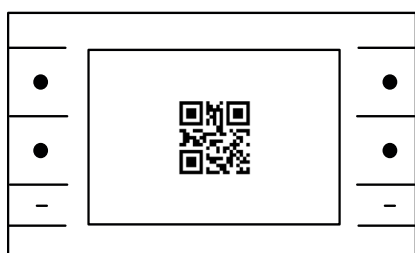
- ▶ Press the 'Business Connect' button.



- Press the 'Pocket Pilot' button.



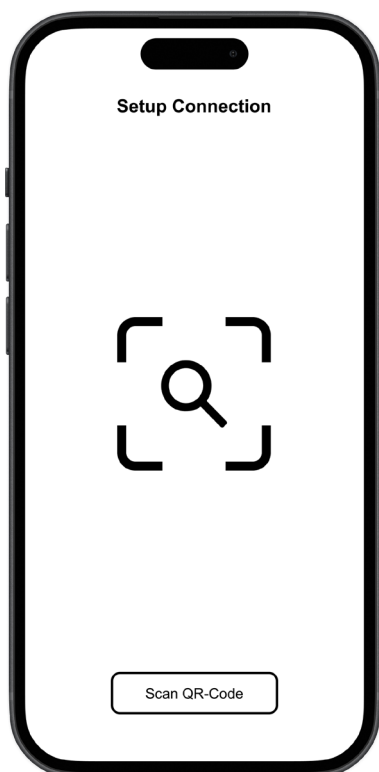
- Press the 'Connect' button.



- A QR code is shown on the display of your coffee machine.

- ▶ Open the JURA Pocket Pilot Management app on your smartphone.
- ▶ Log in with your account created on pocketpilot.jura.com.



- ▶ Touch the 'Scan QR code' button.
- ▶ Scan the QR code shown on your coffee machine's display.
- ▶ Enter the code displayed on your coffee machine's screen.



► Touch 'Pocket Pilot 3.0'.



► Enter the Wi-Fi password. It must be the same as the one you used to connect your smartphone.
